

I personally get to see the faces of the men (and women) and the great joy they experience. The strong voices are powerful in prayer and song. I saw one father who recently lost his wife stand next to his son who is a father-to-be very soon. I witnessed, along with the entire assembly, these men coming to Mass, praying and serving God in so many ways. After Mass, the comments from some of the men included how it was the best Father's Day they ever had. Another said it was amazing to gather with other men at the altar. So many other comments really touched my heart. The sad story is many Catholic parishes miss out on trusting that the people of God can experience such awe and wonder. The separation leads to missing one of the most sacred signs in the sanctuary, the people of God as stated in our liturgical documents.

God is a God who wants to be close to us, Jesus shows us countless times his desire to be close to us. He came to remove barriers to the Father.

To have men hear the invitation to come forward to witness their service to God in front of the community is truly a gift to our parish and other parishes who encourage this idea.

Prayer Shawl Ministry: Sharing the Love of God with Others

As we go through life, especially when we are struggling or feeling lost, we could all use a little reminder of God's love in our life. Sometimes it is the kind gesture of a stranger, sometimes it is a kind word from a family member or friend, sometimes it is a simple gift reminding us that we are cared for and loved. Many times it is a small act of kindness that reminds us that we are not alone. One ministry that understands the need for prayer and kindness is the prayer shawl ministry.

The prayer shawl ministry at St. Patrick combines compassion, love of knitting, crocheting and fellowship into a prayerful ministry that reaches out and provides physical and spiritual comfort to those in our community who are hurting. The mission of the prayer shawl ministry is to provide a tangible reminder of God's love to those in need. Shawls and blankets are given to console those who are grieving, comfort those who are ill, and bring hope to those in despair.

In addition to having prayer shawls available upon request at the parish office, and baptismal blankets/shawls provided to all that are baptized at St. Patrick Catholic Community, this ministry also provides items to the larger community. Since the beginning of January, 2024 they have donated 12 lap blankets, and 49

Twiddlemuffs (fidget sleeves for those with dementia) to Elder TLC, 2 Women's tunics to Homeless Matters, 27 baby blankets and 8 hats to Maggie's Place to name a few. They also donate more than 100 hats, and 80 scarves to Justa Center, Paz de Cristo, and Andre House. The prayer shawl ministry also assists the grief support ministry at St. Patrick by providing prayer shawls to members at the conclusion of their sessions.

As we all need reminders of God's love in our life, the prayer shawl ministry offers both a meaningful and tangible gesture of kindness to those in need. No matter how old or young, if you are interested in being a part of sharing God's love through knitting/crocheting, I encourage you to consider being a part of the prayer shawl ministry. We all have a role to play in sharing God's love with one another, it is up to us to respond to that call.





Puppy - Dog Prayer - My kids know that our dog will be waiting for them when they come home from school. He is always overjoyed to see them. His joy comes from his relationship with our family, and not from the day's happenings while we were away from home.

With that picture of JOY in their minds, I encouraged my kids to start our bedtime prayers with what I call a "puppy-dog" prayer - that is, to begin with all the ways they are joyful. This has become a reminder to greet God joyfully and thank Him for who He is and what He's done for us.
