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EDGE is a dynamic Catholic middle school youth ministry program designed to meet the spiritual, emotional, and social needs of pre-teens and early teens. Through engaging activities, faith-filled discussions, and fun events, EDGE helps young adolescents navigate this pivotal stage of life with a strong foundation in Christ. All Middle School Youth are welcome to attend!

In addition to Monday EDGE Nights from 6:30–8pm, we gather each semester for social nights, better known as **FREDGE or Friday Night EDGE. We gather with our greater parish community for all **Parish Events**. We live out the gospel value of service through our **SP Serves** events that will be published in a separate flyer.**

What happens each week at EDGE?

GATHER Every large group Edge Night begins with a Gather. During the Gather, the youth are welcomed and introduced to the topic of the Edge Night. The Gather includes a game or activity, an essential component responding to the developmental realities of this age group. Games serve the purpose of helping the youth enter into the Edge Night and build community. They also address their need for movement and aid them as they experience a loss of childhood by giving them time to have fun and play.

PROCLAIM The Proclaim provides the teaching on the topic of the session. These engaging talks are given by one member of the core team who has prepared and is well versed on the topic and meets the Middle Schoolers where they are at.

BREAK Youth divide into small groups led by core members for the Break portion of an Edge Night. The purpose of small groups is to provide a safe place for middle school youth to share about their faith, ask questions, and wrestle with what they are learning. As they build community with one another, they grow as disciples of Christ.

SEND The Send concludes each Edge Night with an opportunity to encounter Jesus through prayer. This is a vital part of the Edge Night, and allows us time to build our understanding and habit of prayer.
