

St. Vincent de Paul: A Lesson in Charity and Compassion

This Friday, September 27, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Vincent de Paul. Born to a poor family in the southwest of France, Vincent showed his intellectual gifts from a young age, studying theology at the age of 15. He continued his studies and was eventually ordained a priest in 1600. Although Vincent had initially begun his priesthood with the intention of securing a life of leisure for himself, he underwent a change of heart after hearing the confession of a dying peasant. Moved with compassion for the poor, he began undertaking missions and founding institutions to help them both materially and spiritually. St. Vincent de Paul became known for his empathy, compassion, and his dedication to serving the poor. St. Vincent de Paul truly believed in the intrinsic value of every person. For this reason St. Vincent de Paul is known as the patron of Catholic charities.

To this day, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul continues his work and is dedicated to feeding, clothing, housing and healing individuals and families in our community who have nowhere else to turn for help. They also provide meaningful opportunities for volunteers to serve their neighbors in need with love and

compassion. St. Vincent de Paul also embodies the central message of our annual theme, I will look twice, until I see Christ in you, by showing every person the respect and dignity they deserve.

Following the example of St. Vincent de Paul, St. Patrick is founded on the pillar of social justice, always looking to serve the most vulnerable and accompany those in need. We have a number of ministries and resources available to those looking to get more involved in social justice and outreach. 

Nurses Corner

Suicide claims more lives than war, murder, and natural disasters combined. It is the 10th leading cause of death in the U.S.

Many suicide loss survivors struggle with the outmoded belief that those who die by suicide are condemned to hell.

As Bishop Dolan of the Diocese of Phoenix writes: "The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us... we should not despair of the eternal salvation of persons who have taken their own lives."

Far less than 5% of suicide and substance loss survivors receive the support they need. Those left behind are often stigmatized, isolated, or forgotten. They can lose hope or sadly seek relief in the very thing that took their loved one.




