Stewardship

Knowing God is an attractive quality. Consider that phrase. Think about people in your life who seem to really "know God" well. Perhaps it's your pastor, someone who works at your parish or school. It could be your favorite speaker or author... that soul who just seems to know God on a level that you desire to know Him.

Whoever the person, when we encounter souls who seem to have a deeper connection to the Lord, it is natural for us to be drawn to them. This is how so many preachers and leaders of different denominations can amass such huge followings, given their charisma and giftedness. The problem, however, is when those who seem to "know" God lose touch with Him on a personal level. The first reading gives a stern warning to those priests entrusted with preaching God's truth but who, instead, seek personal glory or comfort. Christ points to the Pharisees and Scribes — all learned men — who lord their knowledge of God's laws over the people even though they are personally far from the Lord in their own hearts. The psalmist praises the children of God who find their peace solely in the proximity and care of their parent. St. Paul carries on that same imagery of a child beloved by God and praises those followers who put up with hardship because they received not just "words about God" but the Word of God (Jesus). The Thessalonians are praised for their faithfulness to God and their humility in "knowing Him." When we know who God is, we also discover who we are.

Ask yourself if people are drawn to you because of your faith, and then consider how well you turn that attention back to the Lord. For if people come to you seeking Christ and only find you, what have you accomplished? As Jesus reminds us, our leadership is rooted in our service, "The greatest among you must be your servant."




