ROCK45 invites 4th & 5th graders to deepen their faith with fun & dynamic evenings that invite them to encounter God's immense love for them.

Each evening we GATHER/PROCLAIM/BREAK/SEND.

Gathering at the beginning of the night as a large group we welcome, pray, and introduce the evening's topic. The gather includes a game or activity to foster friendships and build community. Youth are divided into small groups, which are led by two CORE team leaders. Each small group rotates through a series of 3 stations (ex: games, crafts, topic talk, service, scripture study and/or prayer). We conclude our time together as a large group sharing on what we learned and ending in prayer.

Keeping the youth moving and learning is key at ROCK45. We find students grow deeper in their knowledge of Christ and the teachings of the Catholic Church. Most importantly, ROCK45 helps our youth foster faith based friendships.
