Over the years many people have associated Halloween as something to do with the devil and scary evil things. Some even decide not to celebrate it. Yet this time of year is important to all Christians if we recall the purpose of this time of year.

There are three special days this coming week. Halloween, also known as All Hallows' Eve, is the day before All Saints Day. An ancient understanding of Halloween was to mock or make fun of evil, scary things, to remind us that these things are not as powerful as God. The second day we honor is All Saints Day. In

our Catholic tradition, the past heroes or great role models of faith are remembered by celebrating their "feast days." We honor past men and women who have been great role models. November 1 is the feast day for All the Saints. They are still with us by being the Church in heaven as we are the Church on earth. The third day is All Souls Day on November 2. We remember all who have died, and they too have become part of the Church in heaven. They are signs of Resurrection for us and reminders of God's desire to eat with him at the eternal banquet. So these days are indeed special for Christians.

November 1, All Saints Day, is a holy day and Masses are at 8:00 am, 12:00 noon and 5:30 pm in the church. On November 2, the All Souls Day, Mass will be at 8:00 am in our daily Mass chapel.

**Pass the Word...**One of our main goals is to inform people of the Arizona Baby Safe Haven law. As you may know, St. Patrick Catholic Community is a Baby Safe Haven but, that is only during normal office hours when someone is present in the office to receive a baby. For hours and days when the office is not open a baby can be taken



to the nearest fire station or hospital. The parent or guardian leaving the baby is protected by law from prosecution of abandonment, they can remain anonymous and can not be required to answer any questions. Please help spread the word about this important law that can protect a woman facing an unwanted pregnancy and the life of the unwanted baby. #### Stewardship

**Opening Prayer:** When all else fades, Lord, you are there. When I have nothing left, you are my strength. Thank you, Lord, for your incredible gift of love. May I learn how to love you and all those I encounter like you love me. Amen.

Have you ever "ranked" the Ten Commandments from the least to most important to follow? Does not committing murder really deserve to rank up there with "keeping holy the sabbath," for instance? Even in the time of Jesus, we see the Pharisees and Sadducees asking for a list in order of importance. There were so many commandments to follow, after all, and so few ways to "trap" the Lord into violating the law with His answers.

Being far too smart for His opponents, the Lord summarizes all the commandments in just two. In doing so, Jesus picks up where Moses left off in his instructions to offer love and mercy to your neighbor. How did one follow the Ten Commandments perfectly? It all begins with loving God with everything you are and everything you have. This is why St. Paul told those in Thessalonica to become "imitators of us and of the Lord" not because they were egotistical but, instead, because they were trying to offer a living witness of a new way of life — a life bent on knowing, loving, and serving God and neighbor. They were "all in" and "all His" and were encouraging other followers to follow suit and do the same.

We are to have a preferential option and heart, too, for those who are most in need and most vulnerable, namely widows and orphans. Throughout Scripture we hear "widows and orphans" placed together because the two represented a cross-section who could not take care of or provide for themselves. God is seen repeatedly in both the Old and New Testaments as a champion of those without a voice and loving the Lord means loving all life, even the alienated and the seemingly forgotten.
