
ST. PATRICK LIFE TEEN



Saint Thomas Aquinas names four primary categories people often use as substitutes for God: wealth, power, pleasure, and status. These four areas are alluring and promise safety and security but are waiting to devour us if we trust them too much. The goal of “Wolf In Sheep’s Clothing” is for teens to recognize the four substitutes for God identified by St. Thomas Aquinas and gain insight on how to be counter-cultural by choosing Christ-like virtues.



Every year we take a 40-day journey through the season of Lent. With countless reminders of sacrifice, fasting, prayer, and desert imagery, we may have accepted this season as merely about giving up chocolate or momentarily surrendering our favorite indulgences. But Wait... There’s More! is a Life Night series that helps the teens enter into Lent through various lenses, giving them new perspectives that will lead them to a deeper understanding of Lent and strengthen their relationship with Jesus Christ during this liturgical season.



To be Catholic and to follow Jesus commits us to social justice. The Beatitudes provide a practical roadmap for how we live out our calling to the Kingdom of God. Each of the Beatitudes motivates us and provides tools for us to live out Catholic social teaching. Through them, we will be challenged to hear the difficult but liberating words of Jesus and respond with compassion and justice. The Work at Hand is a Life Night series that inspires teens to live according to the Beatitudes in order to work towards a more just world.
