




Welcome Frank Dominguez Director of Liturgy

#### Prayer

Savior, I ask you today for greater faith. May I be as bold as St. Peter to follow You into the deep, trusting that You will make sure I am always protected. Amen.

This story of the storm at sea is one of the most famous in all the gospels. In this account, we see the Lord send His apostles straight into a storm while He departs to the safety and serenity of dry land for night prayer. Consider that fact, for a moment. Jesus sent them into a storm. Why? Had they gotten on His nerves with their inability to catch fish or their constant questions about who was the best disciple? No. Christ obviously knew what He was doing, allowing His closest followers to go through a storm..and He still does.

Elijah was running for his life and hiding in a cave when God comes and speaks to him (first reading), not in some grandiose gesture of winds or fire but a subtle whisper. Are you quiet enough to hear the whisperings of God? Are your eyes open to see His movement around you or are they too glued to a screen most days? Do you want salvation for your loved ones as badly as St. Paul wants it for the early Christians (second reading)?

Whether or not you are prayerfully seeking God, the good news is that He is seeking you. He's coming into your places of darkness and hiding to speak to you. He's coming out into your storm to save you. Why? Like St. Paul, God wants your salvation even more than you do.





#### **Social Justice**



Allowing oneself to be transformed by the plight of others is one element of the Justice foot of our Catholic faith. In order to do this we must first allow the Holy Spirit into our hearts and minds so the process of transformation can begin. Many wonder how to initiate this.

This Fall 2023, we will again offer the **Just Faith** faith formation classes here

at St. Patrick. The topics to choose from will be Hunger, Migration, or Racial Inequity. The criteria to get involved is simple. Just choose a class session, sign up for it, and show up with an open heart and mind willing to learn.

**Just Faith** modules consist of eight sessions plus one immersion experience. Sessions meet for two hours, once a week. Led by a facilitator, these sessions are designed so that you become a small faith community group which will study your chosen social topic together. Through readings, discussions, videos, prayer, and fellowship you will be brought closer in learning what the gospel looks like in everyday life.

On the face of it, the Justice foot of our faith does not seem as "visible" as our charity foot. Yet, one foot cannot walk without the other. It brings balance. The Justice equation involves behind-the-scenes work within ourselves. You are invited to this Justice formation that will effectively enhance and nurture relationship. The relationship of understanding the plight of others. Justice involves advocating and educating oneself on social topics in order to become a voice that speaks for those who cannot speak for themselves. But how can one do that if we don't even recognize what that plight is or even looks like for others?

Let **Just Faith** open that door of transformation for you. You will have two options at the end of your sessions: First, walk away and say to yourself that you learned a lot. Second, walk away knowing you now have a deeper knowledge but will be transformed enough to discern next steps toward Charity and Justice. Chances are, you will choose the second option.




