Dear Friends,

Our Catholic faith has a great tradition of remembering and honoring holy men and women from the past. Many of them we call Saints. Certain dates on the calendar are special feast days on which we honor different Saints. When I preside at a weekday Mass, I am able to read about the history of the Saint and share the story at Mass during the homily. I am amazed at some of the stories of past Saints.

A common theme in those stories is the courage and endurance that many went through. There was a crisis in the Church, authorities were oppressing people, there was violent persecution, and even fellow Christians, in some cases, caused

pain and suffering for those we now call Saints.

This gives me a great reminder that living our faith in the world is not always easy. It can be scary or fearful to stand up for people and issues that are important to God. It takes courage and wisdom from the Holy Spirit to help us through.

We are to avoid the thought that we gather for Eucharist to escape the problems of the world. To think that we gather only for positive messages that make us feel better, without having to face a difficult world. The joy of the Gospel of Jesus Christ is when we stand for people who are lost or being misused. Our joy comes from being strengthened by the Word of God and the Sacrament to go out into the world to make a difference. There are no stories of Saints who simply thought about themselves, avoided conflict, or difficult challenges that were present in the world. The stories I read about on special Saintly feast days are about heroic and courageous lives that overcame fear.

If our Church or the Gospel never talks about difficult issues or stands up to those who oppress or misuse their authority, then the Gospel means very little. It is meant to transform the world, and it cannot do that if we simply say we gather to escape a broken world. It is our baptism that gives us the call to make a difference in the world. Some food for thought about how we are challenged in difficult times.

# St. Augustine: Doctor of the Church

On August 28, the Church celebrates the Feast of St. Augustine. St. Augustine was one of the most influential Church Fathers and a brilliant philosopher whose life and teachings continue to inspire millions. The title "Doctor of the Church" was given to him because his teachings have significantly contributed to the understanding and growth of the Catholic faith. His explanation of the nature of free will, the role of divine grace, and the importance of the sacraments helped define orthodox belief. St. Augustine's profound insights into theology, grace, the Trinity, and Christian life earned him this esteemed designation.

Born in 354 AD in North Africa, St. Augustine's journey to faith was marked by profound personal struggles and a transformative encounter with God's grace. Before his conversion, Augustine led a turbulent life, indulging in worldly pleasures and sin. Like many of us he sought happiness in pleasures, fame, and intellectual pursuits, often feeling a deep sense of restlessness and dissatisfaction. However, his relentless search for meaning and truth eventually brought him to the teachings of Scripture and the Church. His pivotal moment occurred as he sat contemplating life and his restless heart, he heard a childlike voice saying,

"Take, and read." He interpreted this as a divine invitation to read the Bible. Augustine picked up a Bible and opened to Romans 13:13-14, which urged turning away from sinful behaviors and embracing Christ. Those words struck him profoundly, filling him with peace and clarity. In that moment, Augustine fully committed himself to God. He heard God's call to abandon his sinful way of life and accept Christ as his Lord and Savior.

St. Augustine reminds us that no matter how far we may feel from God, His mercy is always greater. Conversion is a process, and God's grace can transform even the most difficult hearts into saints. This week let us examine our own lives to turn away from sin and seek God wholeheartedly. May we always listen for His voice guiding us to truth and peace.

Minister Opportunities: Parents, Teens and other caring adults are encouraged to volunteer in the classroom.




