



Justa Center



“Justa was a woman with a problem. Her daughter was mentally ill. As a single mother, she wasn’t able to care for her daughter *and* keep her job. Eventually, they lost their housing and were unsheltered.

Justa had the audacity to ask Jesus for help, and when denied, she challenged his answer. She became the first non-Israelite woman to enter into what would become Christianity. The brief encounter can be found in the Christian New Testament book of Matthew, chapter 15 verses numbered 21-28. “

“Justa Center provides life-sustaining resources, services, and support to assist homeless seniors on their path back to housing, and supportive services to help prevent seniors from becoming homeless.”

Andre House

“André House is named after [St. Brother André Bessette, C.S.C.](#) Br. André lived in Montreal, Canada and served at the college de Notre Dame run by the Congregation of Holy Cross. Br. André’s main ministry at the school was to serve as the porter, the doorman. In that capacity he would welcome people to the school, run errands, and overall serve as a minister of hospitality. As he interacted with people, they would share their stories and sometimes ask for prayers. Br. André would pray with them, and also encourage people to pray to St. Joseph. Through these prayers, many healings took place.”

Andre House was started by two Holy Cross priests and the original house at 1002 W Polk, Phoenix, AZ. The house was started as a descendant of the philosophy of the Catholic Worker and Dorothy Day.

The original soup line as told by Br. Richard Armstrong started with a Christmas turkey made into soup and served to the community.

André House strives to be a ministry of hospitality and love. A ministry of presence in serving guests; the community and each other. A ministry rooted in faith.

We continue to dispense the resources needed to remove employment barriers and create success.”

Social Justice

During Black History Month, it is important to recognize those who took the road less traveled. Jackie took the bumpy road so that others behind him could better traverse their path towards success in sports and everyday life. The road was not easy for Jackie, but his efforts and fortitude set the tone in advocating for the dignity of the person and dignity of the rights of workers in his chosen field.

Jackie was born on January 31, 1919 in Georgia but grew up in Pasadena, California raised by a single mother of five. He attended UCLA and excelled in football, basketball, track and field, and baseball. From there he went into the Army. Little known fact was that he was court-martialed (but honorably discharged) for standing up for his rights and refusing to move to the rear of a military bus. In 1945, he was invited to join the all-white Dodger farm team, the Montreal Royals.



His first professional game with the Dodgers was with the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1947 and went on to win Rookie of the Year. In 1955, the Dodgers beat the Yankees in the World Series for their first championship.

Upon retiring from baseball in 1957, Jackie continued to be a leader in the

Civil Rights movement. He was the first African American to be hired to serve in a VP position for Personnel at a company called Chock Full O'Nuts. He continually fought to improve working conditions. In continuing his advocacy efforts, in 1963 he was a speaker at a famed rally in Washington, DC. He was a well known syndicated columnist where he encouraged people in his N.Y. community to become active in politics and business. In 1964, he co-founded the Bank of Harlem and in 1970 he founded the Jackie Robinson Construction Company.

Jackie had a short-lived life with his decade long battle with diabetes. He died in 1972 at the age of 53 years old. Major League Baseball retired his #42 jersey number across the league. His name will forever be remembered as a person who had the courage to break barriers.




