free of charge thanks to your generous stewardship of Giving, Praying, and Serving (GPS)!





PARISH VERIFICATION INFORMATION

from the Diocese Catholic Schools Office

For parents registering their children for the 2023-2024 school year, please note: In order to receive the school's reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your pastor must determine whether your family meets the criteria set by your parish for Registered, Active, Participating members. The definition of registered, active and participating varies by parish, but usually includes attending Mass regularly as well as contributing online or with an envelope to the offertory along with participating in the ministry life of the parish. If you have questions about your family's status, please contact the Parish Office.

Note: All Diocesan high school students receiving the reduced tuition rate for the coming year must have their status verified by their home pastor.

For St. Patrick Catholic Community Parish School Verification, parishioners must be registered, active and participating members for a minimum of six months prior to submitting their form for verification. For further requirements, please contact Torri Winn at twinn@stpatcc.org.

Social Justice



We recognize Mae Jemison during Black History Month in this month of February. Mae was born October 17, 1956 and went on to become the first African American woman to travel in space in 1992. Born in Alabama, her family soon moved to Chicago, Illinois. After graduating high school in 1973 when she

was 16 years old, Mae attended Stanford University and graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering and Bachelor of Arts degree in African-American Studies.

She went on to obtain her medical degree from Cornell University in 1981 and from there became an intern at LA County Medical Center. While obtaining her medical degree, Mae also traveled to Thailand where she worked in a Cambodian refugee camp. In 1983, she joined the Peace Corps and served as a medical officer for two years. She is fluent in Russian, Japanese, and Swahili languages.

Growing up, Mae was always interested in space exploration. In fact, she was inspired by actress Nichelle Nichols who played Lt. Uhura on Star Trek. She applied for the NASA astronaut program in 1987. She was one of the 15 people chosen for the NASA Astronaut Group 12 program out of 2000 applicants! On September 12, 1992 Mae and six other astronauts went into space on the space shuttle Endeavor. This voyage made her the first African American woman in space. Her team made 127 orbits around Earth before returning eight days later to Florida.

Mae left NASA after six years but is still involved in space projects. She is leading the 100-Year Starship project to make sure human space travel to another star is possible. Way before that, though, she actually got to star in a Star Trek episode



herself in 1994. She currently lives in Houston and stays very busy by serving on the Board of Directors on at least ten organizations over the years.
