#### Stewardship

In the first reading, we see why King Solomon is said to be "the wisest man who ever walked the planet" because God, Himself, says so. When given the opportunity to ask God for anything, Solomon doesn't treat God like a genie, asking for fame or fortune or "more wishes" but, rather, asks for wisdom so that he can govern the people well. Would you do that?

St. Paul reminds us in the second reading that all things work for good even though we may not readily see it that way. In other words, even the suffering that God allows will ultimately work for our good and help lead us to heaven. The question is what we do with the truth and knowledge we encounter. Do we pursue it immediately and with abandon like the guy who finds buried treasure or the valuable pearl (in this week's Gospel) or not?

Wisdom dictates that when we encounter God — who is the greatest good — we abandon all for Him. God is patient with us, though, and gives us time. Just as we must wisely discern right from wrong and truth from lies, so will God (and His angels) discern and separate the good from the bad in the end, like a fisherman sorting fish.






