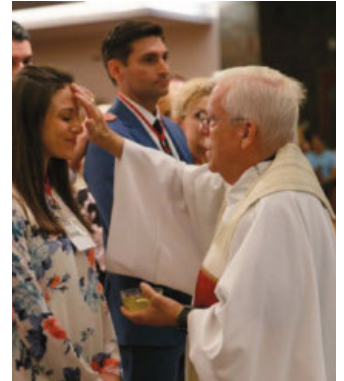

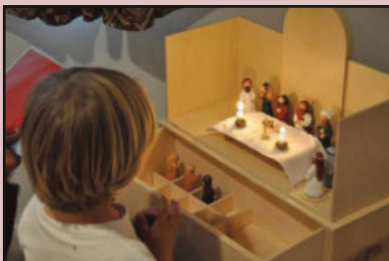
Synod Listening Session Update:

Stewardship

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. What we are commemorating is a central reality of our Christian faith, that God is Trinitarian in nature — three distinct persons in one God.

The Church calls this truth a mystery, as indeed it is. Some have said that “mystery” in this context is “not a wall to run up against but an ocean in which to swim.” Contemplating the “ocean depths” of this mystery can make us humans feel so small, and almighty God so far from us. Yet nothing could be further from the truth as today’s readings demonstrate.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that God is intimately connected to us. “The love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.” God wants to live in the very depths of our being and in all the intimate details of our lives if we will let Him.

And in the Gospel from St. John, we learn that God holds back nothing of Himself from us. Jesus tells His disciples (this includes us!) that the Holy Spirit “will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything the Father has is mine.” Thus, we find ourselves drawn right into the midst of this Trinitarian love. In fact, if the mystery of the Holy Trinity is an ocean in which to swim, the “water” that makes up that ocean is love.

What then should be the response of the Christian steward to this sublime mystery? All we can do is worship. And offer our lives back to God in total gratitude for calling us to live in the richness of such unfathomable love.

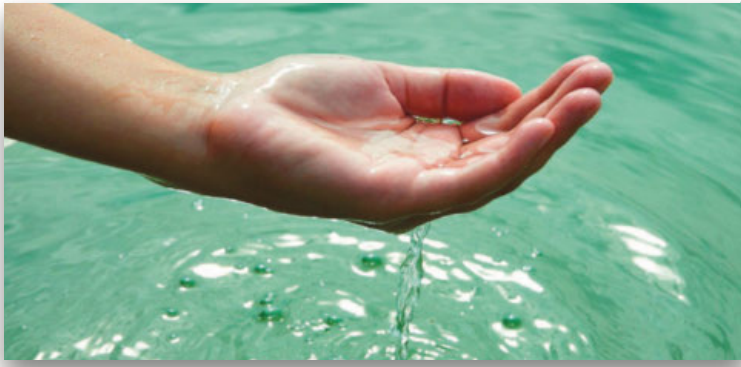

Social Justice

Millions of dollars in newly announced federal funding will be distributed to programs that help provide housing and services to people experiencing homelessness in the Maricopa County region.

Recently, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced the "Continuum of Care" program grant funding to provide critically needed support to local programs serving individuals and families experiencing homelessness. The Maricopa Regional Continuum of Care award of \$35,726,942 provides funding for 32 local homelessness programs.



The announcement comes on the heels of the most recent Point-In-Time (PIT) street count, which found more than 5,000 individuals in unsheltered homeless situations in the region.

The funding will support the following:

Twenty-eight programs that provide housing and services for individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

Coordinated Entry projects to prioritize and place individuals and families in appropriate housing.

The Homeless Management Information System, a local information technology system used to collect data on the provision of housing and services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

Funding for Continuum of Care planning.

The Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) staffs the Continuum of Care and develops the application for HUD on behalf of the region.

Traveling this summer? Prevent Deep Vein Clots

Deep Vein Thrombosis: Blood thickens, forms a clot deep in a vein, typically in thigh or lower leg, the clot can break off,

travel through the blood stream and lodge in an artery in the lungs, resulting in often deadly, blocked blood flow to the lungs (pulmonary embolism) and can reduce oxygen levels to other major organs.

Risks: High blood pressure, smoking, hormone pills, pregnancy, inactivity due to recent surgery, broken bone, long car or plane rides, certain heart or blood diseases.

Signs: Leg swelling, warmth, pain, redness. If clot has already reached your lungs: unexplained shortness of breath, painful breathing.

Prevention: Stretch and exercise your lower leg muscles if you're sitting for a long time while traveling, recuperating from illness, or have other risks. Take medication as directed.

A prompt diagnosis and treatment can prevent complications of deep vein thrombosis. Recognize your risks - don't wait to be seen.

Crossing Paths...with John Seliga

We cross paths with many people in the course of our lifetime. Sometimes it results in a long, lingering relationship - family/old friends. Sometimes the crossing of paths are relatively brief - military comrades/work buddies. Then again it could be a flash, just a few minutes encounter in passing.

Whether it is a quick "Happy Easter" or "Merry Christmas," or helping a stranger change a car tire, the impact could have a far reaching effect. It could make someone feel good. It could even lead to history making events.

Whatever the encounter, one could ask, "Did I help?" Or you could ask, "Did they help me?" A third position could arise, "Did WE help someone else?" The impact of whatever happens on the crossroads, whether large or small, may be unknown and may only come to light long after the event.

There is a place on the West Bank in Israel called El Qubeibeh. Two thousand years ago a couple of people were walking along a road in that area talking about events that had just taken place during the past few days in Jerusalem. As they were walking, a third person joined them. The first couple did not recognize him. He was just another traveler on the road to Emmaus. That road today is a dirt path marked by remnants of ancient Roman paving stones.

As they approached the nearby village of Emmaus, the two suggested that the third person join them because it was getting dark. The two still did not recognize that the third party was Jesus. They sat down to have something to eat. Then their eyes were opened in the breaking of the bread, and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight. The two hurried back to Jerusalem to tell what had happened in Emmaus.

How many times have we met Jesus on the cross roads and did not recognize who it was? But we remember the event and wonder ---.

Events come and go in our crossing of paths. Memories of the encounter brings us back to something, a place, a feeling and maybe a feeling of regained hope. We are all connected on the cross roads to HOPE.
