First Down with Fr. Eric



Dear Friends,

St. Patrick has a strong Ministry of Care, thanks to the many parishioners who have been trained to bring communion, prayers, and presence to the sick and homebound. Our parish boundaries include two major hospitals where we are responsible for the pastoral care of the Catholic patients: Honor Health Hospital on Shea Blvd and the other in North Scottsdale on Thompson Peak Road. Included are over twenty health facilities that are visited to provide spiritual care, as well as visiting the homebound. This ministry has had a strong presence at our parish for the last three decades.

Some good news from our Diocese. We will be assigned a priest as a chaplain for both Honor Health Hospitals that were mentioned. The priest will be living at the rectory at St. Bernadette Parish and will help cover Mayo Hospital, as well as our two hospitals.

The details of how exactly this will work continue to be worked out. I will still be visiting the sick and making anointing calls. The good news is that it will not fall on me alone anymore. We will be able to offer coverage so that each day, there is a priest who can be contacted for anointing. The parish will be supporting half the salary and other expenses for this priest, so we will be committing to support this important ministry.

A good reminder to parishioners is, if possible, to contact the priest for an anointing of the sick sooner rather than later. Waiting until the last moment might find that the priest is not available in a timely manner when other parish responsibilities need to be addressed. Also, the priest can help explain what the anointing is and help the person not be afraid if they think they are not ready to die. The priest is always ready to explain to the person and their families the meaning of this sacrament and help them understand what is happening.

I am grateful to the Diocese for their decision to find a priest who can help us with the many hospital calls in our area.

Christian Disciples in Mission Living Beyond Sunday

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, two great pillars of the early Church whose lives, witness, and martyrdom laid the foundation for our faith. This is especially apparent when you look at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Right at the steps of the Basilica you will find saints Peter and Paul standing at the entrance. These are two men who dedicated their lives to following Christ, igniting the world on fire by spreading the gospel.

This feast reminds us not only of the heroic faith of Peter and Paul, but also of the unity and diversity within the Church. Though very different in background and mission, Peter and Paul worked in harmony to spread the Gospel to both Jews and Gentiles, embodying the Church's universal call.

In our first reading from Acts, we hear about the persecution of the Apostles who feared for their lives. We also get a glimpse into the life of Peter as he is imprisoned and stands steadfast in his faith and his belief in Christ. Peter is chosen by Christ as the "rock" upon which He would build His Church (Matthew 16:18). Despite his human weaknesses, including his denial of Christ during the Passion, Peter's repentance and unwavering faith transformed him into a bold preacher of the Gospel and the first pope of the Church. The faith of Peter is on display even in

the last moments of his life as he is martyred in Rome, crucified upside down, out of humility and reverence for Christ.

St. Paul of course took a different path to Christ as he was originally a fierce persecutor of Christians. His dramatic conversion on the way to Damascus changed everything as he had a personal encounter with Christ. From that moment, he became one of the most passionate and influential missionaries of the early Church. Paul's epistles form a significant part of the New Testament, guiding Christians to this day in doctrine, perseverance, and charity. In our second reading St. Paul testifies to having kept the faith despite challenges and persecution. On this Solemnity, as we honor Saints Peter and Paul, let us be inspired by their examples of courage, faith, hope, and love so that we might have the courage to be modern day witnesses of Christ in a world that is hungry for truth, mercy, and hope. Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us.

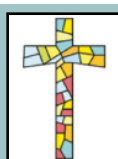

My kids know that our dog will be waiting for them when they come home from school. He is always overjoyed to see them. His joy comes from his relationship with our family, and not from the day's happenings while we were away from home.



With that picture of JOY in their minds, I encouraged my kids to start our bedtime prayers with what I call a "puppy - dog" prayer - that is, to begin with all the ways that they are joyful. This has become a reminder to greet God joyfully and thank Him for who He is and what He's done for us. - Jared H.
