#### Following God into the Unknown

In our Gospel today, Christ tells us, "Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there also will my servant be." We are called to follow Christ wherever he goes, this of course is not always easy especially when we don't know where God is calling us to go. Many times in our life God calls us into the unknown, into a place filled with uncertainty and fear, and this is where God often chooses to form us. It can be difficult to follow Christ into the unknown because we fear change, we fear difference, we fear not being in control. We worry because we can't see precisely where our road may lead us, we feel helpless and we hate it.

Looking at scripture, there are numerous examples of those who dared to follow God into the unknown, those who placed their trust in God's loving care and providence. The church points us to the example of Abraham, the prophets, Mary, and the Apostles to name a few. Each one listened to God's calling and dared to venture onto an unexpected path of service. Through our very baptism we are all called to service, we are all called to be disciples.

On the feast day of St. Patrick, March 17, we also look to him for guidance. St. Patrick knew what it meant to follow God into the unknown, which ultimately led him to become a priest and convert an entire nation. Following Christ goes beyond attending Mass every Sunday. Do not let fear or uncertainty of the future hold you back. God doesn't call us to sit in a comfortable, easy life in the midst of familiarity. Some questions to reflect upon this week may be, how are you following God now and what does serving God look like for you and your family? How can you be of service to others here at St. Patrick?

We leave with this short prayer, often called The Prayer of St. Patrick, to help strengthen you and guide you through the unknown of your journey:

As I arise today, may the strength of God pilot me, the power of God uphold me, the wisdom of God guide me. May the eye of God look before me, the ear of God hear me, the word of God speak for me. May the hand of God protect me, the way of God lie before me, the shield of God defend me, the host of God save me. May Christ shield me today.

Christ with me, Christ before me, Christ behind me, Christ in me, Christ beneath me, Christ above me, Christ on my right, Christ on my left, Christ when I lie down, Christ when I sit, Christ when I stand, Christ in the heart of everyone who thinks of me, Christ in the mouth of everyone who speaks of me, Christ in every eye that sees me, Christ in every ear that hears me. Amen.

#### Stewardship

Have you ever felt frustrated when you see that pinwheel spinning on your computer as it tries to reload a page? Have you gotten annoyed trying to purchase something online and finding out it is backordered? How about when you lose your cell signal and you walk around trying to get a couple of bars on your phone? We can be a bit spoiled by technology that gives us everything almost instantaneously; can you imagine anyone in biblical times getting frustrated over any of these modern conveniences?

This week's readings remind us that God's plan takes time; it unfolds on his timetable, not our own. The first reading from Jeremiah points to a master plan that will necessitate patience and waiting on our part. "The days are coming," we hear at the opening of the passage. We imagine that means this covenant plan will play out in our lifetime. In reality, it was over seven centuries between God's proclamation through Jeremiah and its Eucharistic fulfillment in Christ. How is that for patience?

The gospel points to a process of suffering and death prior to new life and glory. Death to self is often a painful and long process. Do we trust enough in the end transfiguration to endure the temporary "disfiguration"? That's why the second letter from Hebrews is such an important linchpin in the reading. It points to Christ, who patiently and humbly endured suffering with obedience and reverence. In Jesus, we have the model for how we are to not only live but also thrive.







#### NATIONAL WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH



#### Linda Doylek, born County Cork Ireland

What better way to celebrate St. Patrick's Day and Women's History Month than to acknowledge the first woman to lead one of the most well-known.

traditional universities in Ireland.

In 2021, Linda Doyle, 53, broke through Ireland's academic glass ceiling. She is the first woman to be provost (president) of the country's top-ranked university, Trinity College Dublin, The University of Dublin in its 431 year history! She is the 45th provost in school history.

Trinity's provost is elected by faculty members and student representatives, not a board of trustees, as happens with American university presidents. The 431-year-old university has more than 21,000 students and almost 4,000 staff members.

Doyle has several goals for the remainder of her 10-year term, which began in 2021. Most important, she says, is increasing the number of women enrolled in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics programs (STEM). A longtime advocate for the arts, she also intends to introduce more programs that combine creativity with technology.

Doyle grew up in Togher, a suburb of Cork, Ireland. In school, she was interested in math, physics, and chemistry but didn't have exposure to technical topics outside of class.

She had no female engineering role model when she was growing up. She came from a family of modest means. Her father was a printer, and her mother was a homemaker. Doyle herself attended Trinity and had taught there since the 1990's.




