#### Stewardship

These final few weeks of the liturgical year always bring with them more "intense" readings — such as the coming of the Lord in judgment and the end times. The readings are always quick to point out that while "signs" and warnings will accompany Jesus' second coming (as we hear about in the second reading and the Gospel), that ultimately the intention is for all of us to be ready at any time.

If Christ were to come back tonight, would that fill you with peace or with a deep-seeded desire to get to Confession?

Obviously, most of us would love to know the exact hour of Christ's coming so we could be receiving absolution as the skies opened and Christ came down on a cloud, but it doesn't work that way. If we are concerned about Christ's return, that usually signals changes we need to make in our lives. Are we the foolish bridesmaids who acted as though they had no idea the groom was coming, or are we the wise one who was prepared at all times? Do we have a vibrant prayer life, do we frequent Confession and lean into the Mass, or do we only go to God when necessary or forced?

The first reading today might seem a bit out of thematic consistency when you read it, but upon a closer look we see something of an urgent pursuit. Wisdom (the Holy Spirit) is available to all who pursue it. Are we seeking the Lord passionately and urgently each day or only when we feel like it? Do we wake up and go to sleep with God on our mind and holiness the goal of our heart? If we are seeking the Lord, daily, we will be in good shape when the time comes. If we put Christ before ourselves and our own wants, and if our souls, as the psalmist says, are "thirsting for thee" we will find ourselves with full lamps joyfully awaiting the return of the One for whom we have longed.

#### **Social Justice**

Congratulations to the most recent graduates of the JustFaith Immigration Justice Class this past week. Many thanks to both Lulu O' Meara and Sally Wolfe who co-facilitated this eight-week session that took place in our Dorothy Day classroom in the House of Mercy. Participants gathered once a week on Thursday mornings to deepen their knowledge about those persons who face the struggles of migration while also learning about how Catholic Social Teaching shapes their faithful response to this social issue of migration.

Through prayer, discussion, videos, readings, and meditation the class studied topics like:

- ~ Theology of Migration
- ~ History of Immigration to the U.S.
- ~ Current immigration policies and processes
- ~ Why do people migrate?
- ~ Current issues in immigration
- ~ Advocating for change
- ~ Personal discernment of next steps

Common with the JustFaith model, guest speakers were also invited by the facilitators to come and share with the class about their personal experiences and struggles that came with migrating to the United States from their birth countries and why there was a need to flee their homes. 
