Three days this coming week are significant in our Catholic faith. October 31 is known as ALL HALLOW'S EVE, also known as Halloween. Many of us have been formed to see Halloween as scary, evil, and terrifying. The essence was to have humor about our fear of scary things. One ancient thought was that it was a time to mock scary things saying that God has power over such things. All Hallow's Eve is the day before ALL SAINTS DAY, November 1.

Every family has people they honor as role models, people to learn from, and people who bring out the good in others. Our Christian family calls them Saints. The best definition of a Saint that I have heard is, a Saint is a sinner who tries. Saints are reminders that they inspire us to follow Christ and learn from their examples and mistakes.

November 2 is known as ALL SOUL'S DAY. The beauty of our Christian faith is we do not lose our deceased loved ones. Heaven and earth are connected through our love and through the Mass when we eat heavenly bread, the Body and Blood of Christ. Our deceased loved ones are gathered at the heavenly banquet at the same time we gather for our Mass. ALL SAINTS DAY - this Friday, November 1, is a Holy Day and we have Masses in the church at 8:00 am, 12:05 pm, and 5:30 pm. These upcoming three days speak to the world about our faith, not to be overwhelmed when we see evil in the world, we have role models who inspire us, and when our loved ones die, we do not lose them as we will see them again. These three days are a gift.

What's the deal with Catholics and the Saints?

Years ago, I had a friend who once he found out I was Catholic couldn't help but ask me, "What's the deal with Catholics and all those images and statues of saints?" Before then I had never really thought about it; it seemed normal to me to have statues and pictures of the saints in churches. But honestly I really didn't know much about the saints except that they were really holy people a long time ago. It wasn't until years later when I slowly began to read more and learn about the saints that I realized their importance in the life of the Church. As Catholics we believe in a communion of saints which points to reality beyond this material world.

On November 1, we celebrate the Feast of All Saints. This is a day for us to remember the men and women who have gone before us who dedicated their lives to following Christ. The saints offer us examples of what it means to dedicate your life to God. They affirm our belief that the Kingdom of God is worth sacrificing everything for. This feast has a long tradition and finds its origin around the early fourth century in commemoration of all the Christians who were persecuted and martyred for their faith.

Not knowing much about the saints, I often thought it was impossible to be that holy. As Catholics, I think that is the danger for us. We develop a sort of pedestal syndrome. We often place the saints on a pedestal which makes it impossible to relate to them. But in reality they were regular people, just like you and me, searching for happiness and trying to do their best. The saints were sinners too. Learning about the saints is a great way to deepen our own faith.


I encourage you to look up the story of a saint this week and read about their life. To be a saint is not something only a few people are called to be. We are all called to be saints in our own ways.

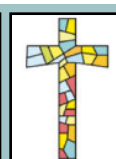

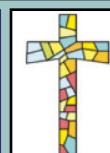

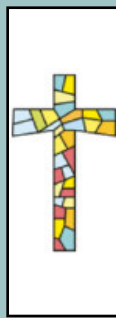
