Dear Friends,

The emphasis of healing in our Anointing of the Sick usually has people focusing on the physical healing. That is understandable as people can visually see the need for that type of healing. The anointing also seeks to offer us healing for our mental health. The challenge can be that we may not visually see the need or understand the need for healing of our minds/mental state. God seeks to offer healing for our mental health as well.

Bishop John Dolan has established the beginning of a Diocesan Office of Catholic Mental Health. St. Patrick has done some important work with mental health through our preaching, talks, podcasts, interviews and resources shared with our parishioners. Recently a representative from our Diocese contacted us to share with the Diocese some of the work we have done in the past, but also help develop a plan of where to begin with this important outreach ministry. I am grateful that we have been asked to share in this ministry on a Diocesan-wide level that will touch many lives.

Not everyone is open to understanding how important mental health services can be for oneself. Whether it is dealing with mental illness, addictions, suicidal thoughts, depression, among other challenges, it will be a powerful sign that the Church community can offer real support, guidance and services. I know our Bishop feels strongly about the educational part of understanding mental health.

We will keep our parishioners up to date on what direction the Office of Catholic Mental Health will take and what information will be helpful to all the faithful and the entire community at large.

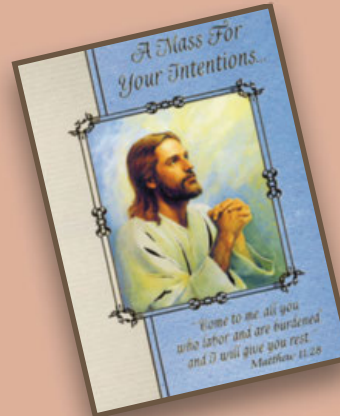

MIRACLES AMONG US...with Torri Winn

What miracles abound in the first reading and the Gospel. From leprosy to flesh "like the flesh of a little child." Amazing! It reminded me that this summer I had an encounter with the miraculous as well. I had the pleasure during a road trip to the great state of Colorado to make a small detour to Santa Fe, NM because of a story I'd heard about a miraculous staircase built by a mysterious man back in 1873. The place is called the Loretto Chapel and the staircase is called ***The Miraculous Staircase***.

The story goes that when the Loretto Chapel was close to completion, the architect died without telling anyone how he had planned to access the choir loft twenty-two feet above. If a regular staircase was built, it would interfere with the interior space of the small chapel. Legend has it that to find a solution to the problem, the Sisters of the Chapel made a novena to St. Joseph, the patron saint of carpenters. On the ninth and final day of prayer, a man appeared at the Chapel with a donkey and a toolbox looking for work. Months later, the spiral staircase was completed, and the carpenter disappeared without pay or thanks. After searching for the man and finding no trace of him, some concluded that he was St. Joseph himself, having come in answer to the sisters' prayers. What makes this staircase "Miraculous?"

It is said that the tools he used were rudimentary at best.



The staircase has two-360 degree turns and no visible means of support.

It was built without nails or glue - only wooden pegs.

The exact wood used to build the staircase is still unknown, although it has been confirmed that it is a type of spruce - which is not native to New Mexico. And scientifically, this wood is not identified anywhere else in the world.

Master carpenters who've been consulted on the staircase, consider it a work of art. Even using modern tools, building this type of structure would be an incredible feat. And this mystery man built it with rudimentary tools and no one to help him.

Now, I believe we don't need to visit Santa Fe to experience miracles all around us. But if you ever get a chance to make a pit stop in Santa Fe, NM, it will be well worth it to take a moment to see the Miraculous Staircase, where possibly St. Joseph himself made a pit stop!

Social Justice

The person being assaulted needs to know that acting to end the abuse does not violate the marriage promises. *(The Catholic Bishops of the United States)*

The most common question people ask about a domestic violence victim is something like, "Why doesn't that person just leave?" or, "Why would that person stay in a situation like that?" These questions seem logical enough, but they are also insensitive to the circumstances and the fear that the victim is trying to navigate. First off, and most common, is that the victim feels the abuser will become more violent and hurt them or those around them should they try to leave. Other reasons why victims hesitate to leave:



Unsupportive friends or family, i.e. no one to turn to which deepens the isolation.

The abuser has control of all finances and the victim has no access to a bank account or cash.

Fear of losing custody of any children or abuser will harm their children out of revenge.

Fear that they will become homeless, especially if there are no family or friends.

Lack of knowledge about access to ongoing safety support and networking.

Religious or cultural beliefs that may dictate outdated gender roles and keep the victim trapped in the relationship. *(The National Committee Against Domestic Violence)*

Part of our call to discipleship is trying to identify with those we serve by looking at their situation through their lens and life experiences. We are called to have a level of compassion and understanding. Judgment is one of the things that victims already live with day to day.

If you are ever in need of **IMMEDIATE** help, call 9-1-1 and get to a safe place. For 24/7 confidential assistance, call the National Domestic Violence Hotline at (800) 799-7233 or you may log on to their website at thehotline.org/.

Always keep in mind that an offender can monitor computer activity. Another option is to Text "START" to 88788.

For parents registering their children for the **2022-2023 school year**, please note: In order to receive the school's reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your pastor must determine whether your family meets the criteria set by your parish for **Registered, Active, Participating members**. The definition of registered, active and participating varies by parish, but usually includes attending Mass regularly as well as contributing online or with an envelope to the offertory along with participating in the ministry life of the parish. If you have questions about your family's status, please contact the Parish Office.

Note: All Diocesan high school students receiving the reduced tuition rate for the coming year must have their status verified by their home pastor before they can be registered as Catholic.

For St. Patrick Catholic Community Parish School Verification, parishioners must be registered, active and participating members for a minimum of six months prior to submitting their form for verification. For further requirements, please contact Torri Winn at twinn@stpatcc.org.
