The Seven Sorrows of Our Lady

On September 15, the Church celebrates the feast day of Our Lady of Sorrows. The title, Our Lady of Sorrows, given to Mary focuses on the intense suffering and grief she experienced during the passion and death of Jesus. Traditionally the suffering of Mary is not just confined to the passion of Jesus but is comprised of seven sorrows which were foretold by the priest Simeon saying, "This child [Jesus] is destined to be the downfall and the rise of many in Israel, a sign that will be opposed and you yourself shall be pierced with a sword so that the thoughts of many hearts may be laid bare" (Lk 2:34-35). Drawing from scripture the common depiction of Our Lady of Sorrows is Mary exposing her heart pierced with seven daggers.

The seven sorrows of Our Lady are: the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the child Jesus in the Temple, meeting Jesus on his way to Calvary, the crucifixion, Jesus being taken down from the cross, and the burial of Jesus. By meditating upon these sorrows, we can better understand what true love looks like and put our own suffering into perspective by knowing with Mary by our side we are never suffering alone.

If you have ever lost a loved one you know what it is like to be in sorrow. It is a painful experience and yet at the same time it can cause us to reflect and appreciate the love we experienced with that person. The celebration of funeral Mass is an example of how sorrow can in its own way lead us closer to God. At the same time, sorrow and suffering can also cause us to reject God and question our faith. The difference depends on whether or not we trust in God and his divine providence. In times of sorrow, we should never feel alone because we have a mother in heaven who is always watching over us. She knows what your sorrow feels like, and she is an example for all of us to turn towards God. We ask Mary to walk alongside us, so just as she received her Son from the cross on the hill of Calvary we too in receiving Him may have our hearts pierced with a sword. Our Lady of Sorrows, pray for us.





1. Contact Us

- Call our main office at **602-749-4405**.
- If we miss the call, please leave your name, phone number, and email so we can reach you.
- You may also email us directly at counseling@cc-az.org.

2. Intake Paperwork

- After the first contact, the parishioner will be sent intake forms via a Secure System -HIPPA compliance.
- Forms should be completed, signed and returned via the secure System or email to counseling@cc-az.org.

3. Match with a Counselor & Start Sessions

- Once paperwork is received, we will match the parishioner with a counselor who can best support them.
- After they are entered into the system, the secretary will reach out to schedule a session.
- The current waiting period is approximately 2–3 weeks.

Warning Signs of Suicide

The behaviors listed below may be some of the signs that someone is thinking about suicide.



Talking about:

Wanting to die Great guilt or shame Being a burden to others

Feeling:

Empty, hopeless, trapped, or having no reason to live. Extremely sad, more anxious, agitated or full of rage. Unbearable emotional or physical pain.

Changing behavior, such as:

- Making a plan or researching ways to die.
- Withdrawing from friends, saying goodbye, giving away important items, or making a will.
- Taking dangerous risks such as driving extremely fast.
- Displaying extreme mood swings.
- Eating or sleeping more or less
- Using drugs or alcohol more often.

If these warning signs apply to you or someone you know, get help as soon as possible, particularly if the behavior is new or has increased recently.


